Dear Potter Lane Residents,

In order to alleviate the parking shortage and guarantee equitable parking for all residents the Board of Directors have adopted assigned parking spaces for buildings 35, 39, 40, and 42 Potter Lane. With everyone's cooperation we hope to make this issue fair to each and every one of you.

Effective immediately we are asking you to park one vehicle in your respective assigned space. Additional vehicles that do not have a space can be parked in the open parking spaces identified in the enclosed sketch.

In addition, guests should NOT park in the resident parking spaces unless their host has forfeited their own ASSIGNED space. Likewise, one unit should not be utilizing more than 2 front spaces at any time.

In the event that you come home to find that your reserved space is occupied, you should not hesitate to ask your neighbor to move their vehicle.

Trading spaces with another resident is fine as long as both residents agree beforehand. In the spring we will put up some signage to help identify the spaces. Until then we will need everyone's cooperation.

We apologize for the temporary inconvenience that this may cause, but we are confident that in time, the assigned parking will be second nature and the civic responsibility that this entails will benefit all of Lakeview.

Finally, we ask that you try to park as close to one another as you can to maximize the parking spaces. Obviously, you should still leave enough room to get in and out of your cars safely.
